Introduction

The second half of this elementary course is intended to teach Japanese words and expressions in everyday situations, and in a variety of circumstances. The course consists of 26 units, which covers most of the range of the N4 level Japanese Language Proficiency Test.

Each unit is made up of the following:

- 1. "Can-Do" List: This list shows what you can do in Japanese after finishing each unit.
- 2. 「かいか (kaiwa)」 Model Dialogues: The typical dialogues including grammatical points and new expressions introduced in each unit, together with a translation to some other languages.
- 3. 「あたらしいことば (atarashi: kotoba)」 New Words and Expressions: A vocabulary list for the entire unit.
- 4. $\lceil h \land b \lor \phi \circlearrowleft (renshu:) \rfloor$ Practice: Various drills such as substitution practice, transformation practice, and usage practice.
- 5. Confirming "Can-Do" List

In the latter part of this book, the explanation in English of Grammatical Points of each UNIT are introduced.
