Grammar

1.N1 のうへ/した/となり/よこ/まえ/うしろ に N2 が あります。

These words are used together with *ni* when you spot the location of a thing/a person. N2 is the subject of a sentence; its location is to be spotted, while N1 should be a noun of place where the thing (the subject) is.

Example 1 つくえの^{うへ}上に、ほん^{ほん}があります。(On the desk is a book.)

Example 2 だいがく^{だいがく}のとなりに、こうえん^{こうえん}があります。(Next to the university is a park.)

Example 3 つくえ^{つくえ}の^{した}下に、ねこ^{ねこ}がいます。(Under the desk is a cat.)
