

## Unit 15 I like sports.

### Can-do

Can-do 1 Able to talk and ask about hobbies.

Can-do 2 Able to talk and ask about preferences.

### Grammar

1. (Person)は N が すきです。

(Person)は N が じょうずです。

‘すき’ and ‘じょうず’ are na-adjective. Negative sentences are made by changing ‘です’ into ‘じゃありません’.

Example わたしは サッカーが <sup>す</sup>好きです。(I like soccer.)

わたしは ピンポンが <sup>じょうず</sup>上手じゃありません。  
(I am not good at playing table tennis.)

2. (duration) に (Numbers)

The article *ni* can also be used to express frequency. *Ni* goes after duration (number with a counter) and before frequency (number with a counter).

Example 1 1 <sup>にち</sup>日に3 <sup>かい</sup>回、<sup>は</sup>歯をみがきます。(I brush my teeth three times a day.)

Example 2 1 <sup>しゅうかん</sup>週間<sup>に</sup>に2 <sup>ほん</sup>さつ、<sup>よ</sup>本を読みます。(I read two books a week.)
